

Standardized Test Score Requirements for Exemption from TU050, TU105, or TU104 courses [Inter Portfolio 1, Inter Portfolio 2, Regional Quota, and Inter Program-Admission 1]

According to the SIIT curriculum, every student may have to study at least one of the following courses, depending on their English competency.

- 1. TU050: English Skill Development
- 2. TU105: Communication Skills in English
- 3. TU104: Critical Thinking, Reading, and Writing

Eligible students who wish to apply for exemption from studying some of these courses are required to submit one of the following standardized English test scores to the SIIT English Training Unit (ETU) for consideration.

For **TU050:** English Skill Development and **TU105:** Communication Skills in English, students may submit one of the following scores. If no score is submitted, the student will be scheduled to study TU050 and TU105 in their 1st and 2nd academic semester, respectively.

Remark:

- 1) Students who are native English speakers and who graduated from an international high school in Thailand are still required to submit a score as stated above.
- 2) Students who graduated from a high school (or the equivalent of) from other countries whose school uses English as the main language for teaching, such as the UK, the USA, Australia, New Zealand, Canada, Singapore, India and countries from around South Africa, are qualified for exemptions, as follows:
 - $2.1)\ An\ exemption$ from taking TU050: English Skill Development course.
- 2.2) To request an exemption from taking TU105: Communication Skills in English, students must submit one of the standardized test score, according to the exemption criteria.



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For **TU104** Critical Thinking, Reading, and Writing, students may submit one of the following scores for consideration. If no score is submitted, the student will be scheduled to study TU104 either in the 1st or 2nd semester.

The score must have been obtained within a 2 year period before the submission date.

For <u>students who previously studied TU050, TU104, or TU105 at Thammasat University</u> within the previous 2 years, a request for exemption from the courses can be submitted together with a copy of the transcript for consideration.
