Types of Scholarships

4-Year continuing scholarships categorized into 5 types as follows:

1. **Young Scientist and Technologist Program (YSTP)*:** SIIT Matching Fund with NSTDA: waiving 100% of SIIT tuition and education support fees in each semester, and includes a living allowance of 5,000 Thai Baht per month, plus other benefits specified by the institute.

Remark: for Thai applicants only

2. **Full Scholarship:** waiving 100% of SIIT tuition and educational support fees in each semester.
3. **Half Scholarship:** waiving 50% of SIIT tuition and educational support fees in each semester.
4. **Quarter Scholarship:** waiving 25% of SIIT tuition and educational support fees in each semester.
5. **POSN Scholarship:** waiving 100% of SIIT tuition and educational support fees in each semester; includes SIIT rental fees. Students who graduate with this scholarship will be considered for a

continued scholarship until the completion of their doctoral degree at SIIT, plus other benefits specified by the institute.

Remark: for applicants who have passed the second camp of POSN Center only

Scholarship Candidates must take the scholarship examinations as follows:

(Applicants who applied for POSN Scholarship will be excepted)

- Engineering Programs No. 1 – 5: Mathematics, Physics, and English
- Engineering Programs No. 6 – 7: Mathematics and English
- Science Programs No. 8 – 9: Mathematics and English

There are no conditions after graduation but scholarship recipients are expected to maintain a GPAX not less than 3.00 for YSTP, 2.75 for full, half and POSN scholarships and assist the institute's work. More details will be given on the agreement signing day.

Application Types (Choose only 1 type of application)

1. Submission of portfolio or other scores

1.1 The applicants must submit their portfolio with a total cumulative grade point average from Grade 10 – Grade 12 or equivalent.

(In case that the applicants are studying in Grade 12 during the application period, the applicants are allowed to submit a total cumulative grade point average from Grade 10 – Grade 11 (4 – 5 semesters) not less than 2.75 from the CGPA system or equivalent along with the portfolio related to the field of interest.)

(Must use SIIT Portfolio Template, and attach in PDF file which must not exceed 50MB/file)

1.2 Submission of other scores which must pass the SIIT minimum criteria **(no minimum GPA or portfolio required)**

1.2.1 Standardized test scores: SAT, A - Level, IB, ACT, etc. **or**

1.2.2 National test scores: GAT/PAT, Common 9 Subjects, etc. **or**

1.2.3 In case of submission of GED scores, applicants must have one of the scores from 1.2.1

(For Engineering Programs No. 6 – 7 and Science Programs No. 8 – 9 only)

1.2.4 (For POSN Scholarship applicants): Attach the academic training certificate in Mathematics, Computer, Chemistry or Physics which issued by POSN Center in 'Certificate of Academic Olympiad Project' menu in the online application system **(attach in a PDF file which must not exceed 50MB/file)** and submit the required documents to email:

institution's schedule, it will be considered a waiver of admission and scholarships (no minimum GPA or portfolio required)

2. Submission of OSP Score

In case of those who have passed the admission criteria of the Outstanding Student Program in Academic Year 2021, both granted scholarship recipients and passed admission criteria can apply in this round without submitting portfolio or other scores.

**Applicants can check the application status of the Outstanding Student Program by logging in at admissions.siiit.tu.ac.th*

Qualifications and Requirements

- Applicants must currently study at a high school level or equivalent, both domestically and internationally, or be in the final year of study and expected to graduate in the academic year 2021.
- Programs no. 1 – 5 applicants must currently study at a high school level or equivalent and must have total credits in Physics and Mathematics not less than 18 credits or equivalent.
- Programs no. 6 – 9 applicants must currently study at a high school level or equivalent and must have total credits in Mathematics not less than 9 credits or equivalent.
- Must have all other qualifications as mentioned in the document “SIIT Announcement on Qualifications of Applicants for Undergraduate Admission”

Remark: Applicants must earn a high school diploma that complies with the curriculum of the Ministry of Education (Thailand) or its equivalent before the TU new student registration period.

2. Portfolio (must use SIIT Portfolio Template, and attach in PDF file which must not exceed 50MB/file) or a copy of other scores as mentioned in “Application Types” 1.2 or a copy of the academic training certificate which shows that the applicants have passed the second camp of POSN Center.

SIIT has 3 fields of study as follow:

All SIIT students are eligible to select Major Academic Programs at the end of their first academic year. Successful admission to a preferred major depends on a student's grade-point average at the end of their first academic year, as well as the demand for the chosen program. Priority for selection will be given to the students who have selected that field of study at the time of their admission to SIIT.
