- Health and accident insurance during the period of scholarship in Thailand

### Candidate Qualifications:

- Non-Thai nationality (from Asian countries)
- Earn a high school diploma that complies with the curriculum of the Ministry of Education (Thailand) or its equivalent from other countries (grade 12 or equivalent)
- Have good behavior and a clean record with no offences against student discipline.
- Have not been granted other SIIT Continuing Scholarships.

Submission of one of the following scores:

1. National test scores from Cambodia, Vietnam, Sri Lanka, Bhutan, Pakistan or China
2. Standardized test scores: SAT I, SAT II, IB, IGCSE, GCE "O" and "A" Level, ACT etc.
