



**Standardized Test Score Requirements for Exemption from
TU050, TU105, or TU104 courses
[Inter Program-Admission 2 and EFS (U)]**

According to SIIT curricula, every student may have to study at least one of the following courses, depending on their English competency.

1. TU050 English Skill Development
2. TU105 Communication Skills in English
3. TU104 Critical Thinking, Reading, and Writing

Eligible student who wishes to be exempt from studying some of these courses may submit one of the following standardized English test scores to the SIIT English training unit (ETU), for consideration.

For **TU050 English Skill Development** and **TU105 Communication Skills in English**, students may submit one of the following scores. In case that no score is submitted, the student will be scheduled to study TU050 and TU105 in their 1st and 2nd academic semester, respectively.

Remark:

1) Students who are native English speakers and graduated from an international high school in Thailand are still required to submit a score as stated above.

2) Students who graduated from a high school (or equivalent to) from other countries whose school uses English as the main language for teaching, such as UK, USA, Australia, New Zealand, Canada, Singapore, India and the countries from around South Africa, would have an exemption according to the following details:

2.1) An exemption from taking TU050 English Skill Development course.

2.2) To request for an exemption from taking TU105 Communication Skills in English, students should submit their score results according to the submission deadline.



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For **TU104 Critical Thinking, Reading, and Writing**, students may submit one of the following scores for consideration. In case that no score is submitted, the student will be scheduled to study TU104 either in the 1st or 2nd semester.

The score must be obtained within 2 years before the submission date.

For **students who previously studied TU050, TU104, or TU105 at Thammasat University** within the previous 2 years period, a request to be exempt from the courses can be submitted together with a copy of the transcript for consideration.

Submission Procedures:

- For **O-NET score taken in academic years 2020-2021, TU-GET PBT, TU-GET CBT, New SAT (Reading & Writing), GCE A-Level, IBDP, NCEE, Old SAT Reading, and GSAT (Reading & Writing)**, please provide the information and upload a copy of the score sheet at: shorturl.at/mxGW3 by **Friday, July 16, 2021**. In addition, a hard copy of the score and information for login to verify the score, must be submitted to the English Training unit (ETU) at the CGS Department (3rd floor of the SIIT Main building), when SIIT resumes its normal operation.
- For **TOEFL IBT and IELTS scores**, please provide the information and upload a copy of the score sheet at: shorturl.at/mxGW3 by **Friday, July 16, 2021**. In addition, an official hard copy must be submitted directly from its respective testing services via a postal mail, to the following address:

Exemption of TU10x by GREAT exam scores.

The following TU10x courses, e.g.

Civic Engagement (TU100), Thailand, ASEAN, and the World (TU101), Social Life Skills (TU102), Life and Sustainability (TU103), Creativity and Communication (TU106) and Digital Skill and Problem Solving (TU107), may be exempt by using eligible GREATS exam scores.
